# Advice for learner drivers when supplying your provisional driving licence

### details to your driving instructor

From 8th June 2015 you will no longer be supplied with a paper counterpart when your provisional licence arrives. The paper counter part used to hold information about any endorsements and driving bans.

All driving instructors are required to check your licence before you can drive their car.

This is simple to do and the following pages will provide you with all of the information you need.

#### Option 1 - Prior to your first driving lesson Printed information about your licence

- You MUST have your provisional driving licence, national insurance number and postcode with you to use the online licence checking system.
- 2. Go to https://www.gov.uk/view-driving-licence
- 3. Read the instructions and click 'View now'
- 4. Enter your
  - Driving licence number
  - National insurance number
  - Postcode that is on the driving licence





## Option 2 - Sharing your licence information online with your instructor

- Alternatively you can share your licence information with your instructor online.
- Click on 'share licence information'
- Then 'Create a code'
- Once the code has been created you need to give this to your instructor with the last 8 digits of your provisional driving licence number.
- Your instructor can then login to the DVLA website and see information about your licence. This is the only information they can see about you.
- This code will only last for 72 hours so make sure you send the information to your instructor as soon as possible.



Click on View, print or save your licence information.
